FACT SHEET – About the SMU-CBS structured exchange programme

The programme is open to SMU students taking the Maritime Business and Operations Track (MBOT) and CBS student pursuing the Bachelor of Science in International Shipping and Trade. Students from both universities will be required to complete one year of maritime studies in their home universities before they embark on the exchange programme.

SMU MBOT students going to CBS will be offered three compulsory courses, namely *Big Data Analytics for Managers*, *Risk Management*, and *Markets, Regulation & Security in the Maritime Sector*, in addition to one CBS elective of their choice.

CBS students coming to SMU will attend three compulsory courses, namely *Port Focal-Logistics & Maritime Operations* and *Sustainable Shipping & Ports* (both of which are courses under the MBOT), *Shipping Finance*, and one SMU elective of their choice. They can also attend any of the non-credit-bearing courses and site visits offered/organised by ITI@SMU.
