This is the first outdoor performance of Fuerzabruta in Asia.

They have also collaborated with home-grown artistes to produce cross-cultural music to accompany the performances.

Fabulo Daquila, general coordinator, Fuerzabruta, said: "We are going to bring this parade to the street. The highlight of that part is the crane, where an actress hangs from there and the crane goes over the heads of the audience."

Ozono Producciones has performed the Fuerzabruta in more than 30 countries around the globe.

The Argentinian acrobats will be performing this Friday and Saturday at the Singapore Management University.

Their showcase piece, La Argentina, will see Dunman High students, drum group Bloco Singapura, DJ Kiat, beatboxer Dharni and The Analog Girl collaborating with the acrobats.

Fuerzabruta is one of the highlights of this year's Night Festival, which promises to transform the area between Cathay Building and Armenian Street into a carnival ground.
