SINGAPORE: Singapore Management University (SMU) and Singapore University of Technology and Design (SUTD) have launched a dual degree programme in technology and management.



It will be offered in the new academic year 2014 with the first intake of up to 45 students in May.

Students will graduate with two degrees -- Bachelor of Engineering from SUTD and Bachelor of Business Management from SMU.

Throughout the four-year programme, students will take SUTD and SMU courses at both campuses.

They will be allowed to take modules from both universities as well as modules that are codeveloped by the universities.

Students will also undergo a compulsory 16-week internship programme and clock in 80 hours of compulsory community service.

They will also stay at the SUTD hostel in the first three terms of their study, or for a period of one year.
