The first three Conclaves (2010, 2011 & 2012) were primarily devoted to understanding the malady.

Since 2013, having discussed the problems and challenges in great detail, the focus shifted on finding solutions to the challenges. To facilitate this, MBAUniverse.com held the 1st IMC Awards to highlight Case-studies where B-schools made a difference with innovations in marketing, pedagogy, curriculum and industry-engagement. Overall, IMC 2013 was partially successful in shifting the focus from Challenges to Solutions.

The IMC Awards 2014 promise to be bigger and better, with greater participation from 100+ B-schools & Universities. Eminent IMC Jury will judge and select the best case-studies from B-schools. The selected B-schools initiatives will be invited to present their cases.
