THE Securities Investors Association of Singapore (Sias) is organising a week of events next month to promote the importance of corporate governance.

A series of programmes has been planned for the inaugural Corporate Governance Week, as it is called.

These include the 11th Investor's Choice Awards, a two-day Asian Investors' Corporate Governance Conference, four executive workshops and a seminar for firms listed on Singapore Exchange's junior board Catalist.


Commenting on the week's activities to be held from Oct 4 to 8, Sias president and chief executive David Gerald said good corporate governance is the cornerstone that upholds the integrity of corporations and financial institutions. He added: "More importantly, through this initiative, we aim to highlight the message that good corporate governance practices are central to the health and stability of our financial markets and economy as a whole."

One of the key events of Corporate Governance Week is the Asian Investors' Corporate Governance Conference. At this event, corporate governance experts and professionals from around the region will be speaking on the theme of "challenges in Asia's capital markets" and leading discussions on trends, developments and best practices in corporate governance.
