The forum will also give the 300-strong member audience a chance to pose questions to Mr Heng at a dialogue session moderated by editor of The Straits Times, Mr Warren Fernandez. There will also be a panel discussion on child motivation led by the newspaper's senior education correspondent Sandra Davie.
