Headline: SMU team wins global law competition again

SMU team wins global law competition again

A team from the Singapore Management University (SMU) has become the first university to win the Price Media Law Moot Court Competition twice.

Organised by Oxford University, the competition – which is into its ninth edition this year – focuses on the freedom of expression and related rights.

SMU topped India's Jindal Law School in the final round, which was presided by a judge from the European Court of Human Rights.

In the general rounds and knockout stages, SMU defeated Catholic University of Eastern Africa; the United States' Regent University and Brooklyn Law School; Renmin University of China; York University's Osgoode Hall Law School of Canada; and the University of Technology Sydney.

More than 100 teams participated this year, and over 40 teams made it to the international rounds held in Oxford between March 30 and April 2.
