

ENOC hosts international student delegations on educational visits to Dubai

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Students from Singapore Management University, Duke University and San Francisco University visit ENOC Dubai, UAE; February 15, 2014: Emirates National Oil Company (ENOC) hosted international students from renowned universities, for a series of educational visits recently.
