Historia SG 2013: The Story of the old Bras Basah

Jail: In the mid-nineteenth century, the colonial government in Singapore built a jail at the foot of Fort Canning Hill, where the Singapore Management University resides today. Indian convicts transported to Singapore served their sentences in the prison and worked as labourers. Join National Museum of Singapore curator Ng Ching Huei as he introduces the old Bras Basah Jail, its convict labourers and their role in the development of early Singapore. This lecture will be conducted in Mandarin.
