LEGAL talks, clinics, private sessions with lawyers and even a book called Know The Law Now! will highlight next month's Law Week.

And everything is for free.

The talks and clinics, to be held from July 22 to 25 at the Subordinate Courts, are jointly organised by the Singapore Academy of Law and the Law Society.

The sessions are aimed at raising public awareness of one's legal rights and will cover topics such as criminal proceedings, employment matters, family law and consumer protection.

A complimentary book, giving brief information on areas of law that impact the average person, will be given to those attending the talks on July 22 and 24.

The book is also available in Chinese.

Members of the public can sign up for a free one-to-one session at the legal clinics on July 23 and 25. Each person will be given up to 20 minutes to consult any of the volunteer lawyers.

Law student volunteers from the National University of Singapore Pro Bono Group and Singapore Management University Pro Bono Centre will be there to help.

The last day for registration is July 12. Due to limited places for the talks and legal clinics, those interested are encouraged to sign up early.
