

President appoints two new Judicial Commissioners



TWO more Judicial Commissioners of the High Court have been appointed, bringing the number of Supreme Court judges to 15.

President Tony Tan Keng Yam appointed Mr George Wei Sze Shun to join the Supreme Court from Aug 1 and Mr Edmund Leow from Oct 1.

Both will serve a one-year term.

Mr Wei, 58, is an expert in intellectual property law in Singapore and was a professor at the Singapore Management University.

Mr Leow, 50, specialises in tax and corporate law and is the managing principal of law firm Baker & McKenzie.
