S'pore happiest nation in Asia

We are the happiest nation in Asia, according to a survey of 156 countries and regions published by the United Nations Sustainable Development Solutions Network. Released on Monday, the 2013 World

Happiness Report ranks the happiest places around the globe.

Singapore went from No.33 to 30 in the survey. Researchers asked an average of 3,000 residents of each place to rank their life satisfaction and identified major categories, looking at both people's emotions and how they rated their lives as a whole.
