### SG:D Scholarship (Undergraduate)

#### CRITERIA:

Be a Singapore citizen; have a good co-curricular activity (CCA) record; possess a strong interest in a career in the ICM industry; commence university studies within one year of award (i.e. commence studies latest by academic year 2022 for 2021 awardees)

For full scholarship: A/IB/ IP Level or polytechnic diploma holder pursuing an ICM-related degree at a local or overseas

For mid-term scholarship: existing student pursuing an ICM-related undergraduate degree at a local or overseas university with minimally one academic year of study remaining from point of award

#### VALUE OF THE AWARD:

Tuition and other compulsory university fees; annual living allowance and a one-time computer allowance; medical insurance and visa fees. and other relevant fees where mandatory; funding support for courses and school curriculum; support for overseas experiences including overseas internships, student exchange programmes, and competitions

#### **BOND PERIOD:**

Five years (full overseas scholarship); three years (full local scholarship); four years (Fast Track Bachelors-Masters Scholarship); between one and four years (mid-term local or overseas scholarship)
