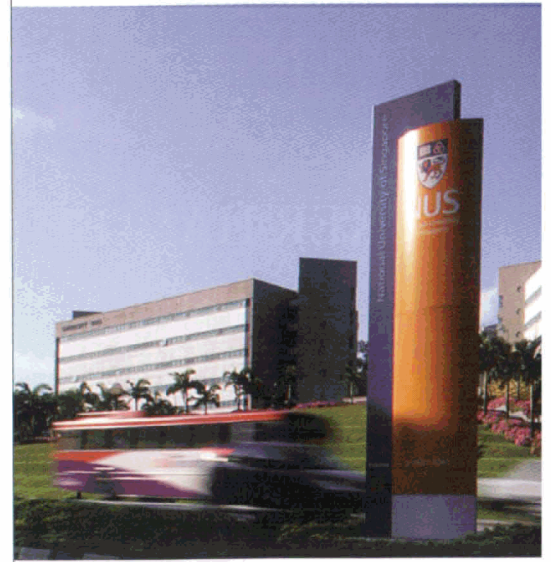

National University Of Singapore (NUS)

This prestigious university is celebrating its 100th anniversary this year. Just last year, NUS was rated 18th in a global ranking of universities by *The Times Higher Education Supplement*, making it one of only three Asian universities (the other two being the University of Tokyo and Beijing University) to be rated among the Top 20.

STUDENT INTAKE Over 6,000 each year.

POPULATION OF STUDENTS About 23,000 undergraduates and 9,000 postgraduates.

COURSES OFFERED NUS has 14 faculties and schools. Courses range from Arts and Social Sciences, Business, Medicine and Science to Architecture and Engineering amongst others.

POSTGRADUATE COURSES NUS has 14 postgraduate schools offering programmes by course work or dissertation. Faculties also offer postgraduate programmes at Masters and Doctorate levels.

COLLABORATIONS Massachusetts Institute of Technology University, John Hopkins University, Georgia Institute of Technology and Fudan University amongst others.

FACILITIES NUS's Kent Ridge campus has six libraries and 35 lecture theatres. It houses four museums, and recreational and sports facilities as well as a University Cultural Centre. Wireless Internet access available campus-wide.

ACCOMMODATION There are currently six Halls of Residence on campus and these provide comfortable accommodation.

3. Singapore Management University (SMU)

Established in 2000, SMU holds a unique position as Singapore's first private university funded by the government as well as being the only city campus. Modelled after the Wharton School of the University of Pennsylvania, SMU's curriculum aims to groom business leaders and creative entrepreneurs capable of excelling in a rapidly changing world. SMU also taps successful businessmen for their specific expertise and management skills.

STUDENT INTAKE About 1,200 each year.

POPULATION OF STUDENTS The University is currently home to 3,800 students.

COURSES OFFERED The University comprises four schools—the Lee Kong Chian School of Business; the School of Accountancy; the School of Economics & Social Sciences; and the School of Information Systems.

POSTGRADUATE COURSES SMU also offers postgraduates programmes in Accounting, Economics and Finance (by research), Applied Finance and Wealth Management.

COLLABORATIONS The University has collaborations with IT-renowned Carnegie Mellon University, University of Chicago and International University in Germany.

FACILITIES It has just moved to its \$450 million city campus that is fitted with state-of-the-art equipment. The university has an underground linkway between their five campus buildings and recreational facilities.

ACCOMMODATION Currently, there isn't any on-campus, but there are plans to provide accommodation in the Bras Basah area.

2. Nanyang Technological University (NTU)

The Nanyang Technological University (NTU), established in 1991, has its origin in the former Nanyang Technological Institute (NTI), which was set up in 1981 with the primary function of providing facilities for tertiary education and research in various branches of Engineering and Technology. NTU was ranked 50th globally and seventh in Asia by *The Times Higher Education Supplement* in a 2004 ranking of the world's best universities.

STUDENT INTAKE Over 5,000 every year.

POPULATION OF STUDENTS About 16,000 undergraduates and 7,000 postgraduates.

COURSES OFFERED The university offers programmes in Accountancy, Business, Engineering, Communication Studies, Maritime Studies and Arts and Science (Education).

POSTGRADUATE COURSES All the faculties offer graduate diploma courses and graduate degree programmes.

COLLABORATIONS It has many joint programmes with top universities including the Singapore-MIT Alliance, Singapore-Stanford Partnership, Cornell-Nanyang Institute of Hospitality Management, and Singapore-University of Washington Alliance in Bioengineering.

FACILITIES The campus boasts six libraries, a Chinese Heritage Centre and Research TechnoPlaza, a research hub set up in 2003.

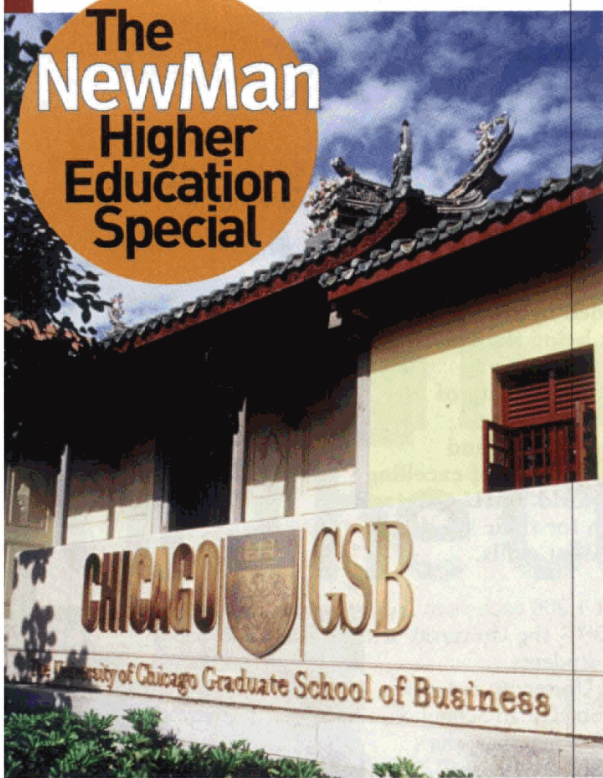
POSTGRADUATE COURSES They only offer postgraduate programmes and these include MBA courses, higher diplomas and certificates.

5. University of Chicago Graduate School Of Business

This prestigious school's Asian campus offers a fulltime executive Graduate School of Business programme taught by the same faculty that teaches at the school's Chicago and Barcelona campuses. Designed for professionals with 10 or more years of working experience, the programme's convenient modular format allows a student to pursue a course while working. The courses also allow students to gain a broad knowledge of business fundamentals, as well as sharp analytical and creative problem-solving skills that extend beyond the jobs and the industry they are in. A unique feature is that students go for a week-long orientation at its Chicago campus before they start their course in their own country.

STUDENT INTAKE In Singapore, 80-95 a year
POPULATION OF STUDENTS Currently, about 190 students are enrolled in the Singapore campus.
POSTGRADUATE COURSES OFFERED While there are a variety of bachelor degrees offered in their Chicago campus, in Singapore, the school only specialises in the Executive MBA programme.
COLLABORATIONS The Singapore campus has none. However, professors from Chicago are flown in for lectures.
BEST KNOWN FOR Its Executive MBA programme. Taking on this course also allows for

great opportunities to network with people from around the world as the programme attracts students from various countries.

FACILITIES The campus has a state-of-the-art lecture theatre and student rooms equipped with their own computers and laser printers. There is also a fully-equipped business centre for students to use.

ACCOMMODATION None, but overseas students can contact the school to assist in negotiating for special rates for stays in hotels.

6. Singapore Institute Of Management (SIM)

One of the oldest private educational organisations in Singapore, SIM was founded in 1964 by the Economic Development Board. Currently in partnership with eight international universities and offering more than 50 academic courses from certificate to postgraduate levels; SIM's strength lies in its comprehensive industry-relevant learning programmes. Awards garnered include the Singapore Quality Class (SQC) in recognition of its excellence in business learning in 2002; and it also attained a SQC for Private Educational Organisations in 2003.

STUDENT INTAKE 10,000 students.

POPULATION OF STUDENTS Of the 10,000 enrolled, more than half are fulltime students.

COURSES OFFERED Bachelors programmes are focused on business-related disciplines including management, accountancy and finance; as well as mass communication and health sciences.

POSTGRADUATE COURSES Doctorate and Masters programmes are available, all part-time.

COLLABORATIONS George Washington University, Royal Melbourne Institute of Technology University, University of London, University of Manchester, University of Sydney, University of Melbourne and University of Wollongong.

FACILITIES Has three centres around Singapore, each of which offer fully-equipped libraries, lecture theatres, computer laboratories and Bioelectronic laboratories.

ACCOMMODATION: SIM's Student Care & Services (SCS) Department assists international students to find accommodation while they are at SIM.

7. Informatics

Established in 1983 in response to Asia's rising demand for skilled Information Technology manpower and knowledge-based workers, Informatics also holds the honour of being the first private lifelong learning company to obtain an SGX-SESDAQ listing in May 1993. Besides Informatics Computer School, Thames Business School, Ruige Applied Computing Centre, Informatics Professional Development Centre and Computer Assisted Learning Training Centre are also owned by the group.

STUDENT INTAKE Over 60,000 students have graduated from Informatics.

POPULATION OF STUDENTS The campus has the capacity to hold 15,000 students.

COURSES OFFERED Diploma and degree options are available in disciplines such as Information Technology, Business and Engineering.

POSTGRADUATE COURSES OFFERED Fulltime Masters programmes are available at their Institute of Postgraduate Studies.

COLLABORATIONS The University of Wales, Royal Melbourne Institute of Technology University and Curtin University.

FACILITIES 80 fully furnished lecture halls, plus computer and engineering laboratories. There is also wireless access throughout the campus.

ACCOMMODATION Housing options are available in the Novena and Katong areas for international students.

8. Asian Centre For Professional Education (ACPE)

The ACPE is the result of a joint effort between educational services provider Centre for Professional Studies (CPS) and the Entrepreneur's Resource Centre (ERC). One of ACPE's core organisational values involves personalising services to fit the needs of its students and providing top-notch educational programmes from reputable institutions.

STUDENT INTAKE There are three intakes per year for its MBA programme and on average, 15 students enroll per intake. For the Diplomas, an average of 30 students enroll per intake and recruitment is done three to six times a year.

POPULATION OF STUDENTS There are currently 200 diploma students, 250 MBA students and 50 PhD students

COURSES OFFERED Diploma in Finance, Wealth Management and Enterprise Management and Degree in Entrepreneurial Management. Newer courses like the Diploma in Business, Diploma in Business (Real Estate Management), Diploma in Business Information Technology and Diploma in Hospitality Management have been launched.

POSTGRADUATE COURSES OFFERED Masters in Entrepreneurial Management, Masters in Finance, plus PhD courses in these fields

COLLABORATIONS Entrepreneurship Institute Australia (EIA) and International Professional Managers Association (IPMA)

FACILITIES Five state-of-the-art seminar rooms well-equipped with teaching aids, comfortable seatings and wireless Internet connection. By end September, six more seminar rooms will be ready. It also boasts a library with more than 800 books.

ACCOMMODATION None, but they do try to match students with an ideal place to stay.
